


ABOUT THE EDITOR/INTERVIEWER

Vic Sarin, born in Kashmir, India, is a renowned Canadian filmmaker celebrated as a director, cinematographer, and screenwriter. Moving to Canada in 1963, he began a long career with CBC Television before establishing his own company, Sepia Films. His cinematography

credits include *Margaret's Museum*, *Whale Music*, and *Riel*. As a director, his award-winning films include *Hue*, *The Boy from Geita*, *Keepers of the Magic*, *and Partition*. Among his accolades are the Directors Guild of Canada Lifetime Achievement Award and appointment to the Order of Canada in 2022. He is the author of the book *Eyepiece*: *Adventures in Canadian Film and Television*.
